SNACK: LET'S TAKE A TRIP!

God told Abraham to leave his country, his family and go to a place that He would show him in a new country. Abraham obeyed God, packed up his family and took a trip—sleeping in tents along the way!

Let's make this snack and talk about Abraham's faith, and how God might wants us to obey Him no matter what or where He might want us to go!

SUPPLIES:

1. Graham Cracker sheets – 1 ½ full sheets (10 sections)
2. Pretzel sticks
3. Fruit Roll-up
4. Mini Nilla Wafers (2), or Teddy Grahams (2), or Sour Patch Kids (2)

INSTRUCTIONS:

To Make the Tent:

- Use ½ a sheet of Graham Cracker to form one side of the tent
- Stand the other ½ sheet of Graham Cracker up next to the first sheet- touching at the top to form a triangle / tent

To Make the Fire:

- Stand pretzel sticks up to make a fire

To Make Abraham and Sarah:

- Use ¼ sheet of Graham Cracker to form the bottom of each sleeping bed (2)
- Place the Nilla Wafers, Teddy Grahams or Sour Patch Kids (2) on top of Graham Cracker bed
- Wrap the Nilla Wafer, Teddy Graham or Sour Patch Kid with Fruit Roll-up for their cover.
