

# LET'S LISTEN TO GOD



As we study God's Word, we learn how important it is to listen for God's voice. He speaks to us in many ways. One big way God speaks to us is through His Word, the Bible.

Today we're going to spend some time listening to what God's Word says. While you're listening to God's words, use paper and markers to draw, or clay to shape into what God is talking about. Is there something He wants us to hear and do?

## SUPPLIES:

- Play dough / clay
- OR drawing supplies—paper, pencils, markers, crayons

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Have someone read these passages from the Bible:  
Psalm 66:1-4  
Psalm 84:1-4  
Psalm 99:1-3
2. Have kids listen carefully and use the clay or art supplies to make/draw something to represent what they hear in God's Word.
3. Ask kids to listen for God's voice and talk about what stood out to them in the Bible verses that were read. Talk about what God might to be telling us through His Word.
