# **DISCOVERY QUESTIONS**FOR FAMILY OR GROUP STUDY

- 1. What are you thankful for? What challenge or stress are you facing? (Consider praying about these together.)
- 2. Read Luke 4:14-22 together (at least twice), and take turns retelling it in your own words as if sharing with a friend who isn't here.
- 3. What stands out to you and why? What do these verses tell us about God? What do these verses tell us about humanity/about us?
- 4. If this is God speaking, how will you apply it to your life? (Aim for a specific: "I will..." step of obedience.)
- 5. Who will you share with before we meet again? (Name a specific person you want to **share with.**)
