Isaiah 52 & 53

On Palm Sunday Jesus is heading into Jerusalem to deal with a

a pandemic.

Isaiah 52:1 > Pay attention! Wake up!

Isaiah 52:2 > Get up! Rescue is coming!

Isaiah 52:3 > You are going to be redeemed without money!

Isaiah 52:7 > Good News! God's going to do it.

Isaiah 52:12, 14-15 > He will do it all! You will be astonished!

Isaiah 52:13 > Note carefully three words

Isaiah 53:1 > Totally unexpected!

Who is this servant (Isaiah 52:13)?

Does the Bible specifically say Isaiah 53 is about Jesus?

Holy ground ***Acts 8:25-35***.

THE ONE THING:

Tell them about the cure.

NEXT STEPS

- Memorize Isaiah 53:6.
- Ask God for opportunities to tell about Jesus.
- Participate in the Good Friday Experience online.
- Celebrate the Lord's Supper with your family today.

NOTES FOR FAMILY OR GROUP STUDY

1. What are you thankful for? What challenge or stress are you facing?
(*Consider praying about these together.*)
2. Read Matthew 8:14-20 together (at least twice), and take turns retelling it in your own words as if sharing with a friend who isn't here.
3. What stands out to you and why? What do these verses tell us about God? What do these verses tell us about humanity/about us?
4. If this is God speaking, how will you apply it to your life?
(*Aim for a specific: "I will..." step of obedience.*)
5. Who will you share with before we meet again?
(*Name a specific person you want to **share with**.*)
