 Isaiah 52:1 ➤ Pay attention! Wake up!

 Isaiah 52:2 ➤ Get up! Rescue is coming!

 Isaiah 52:3 ➤ You are going to be redeemed without money!

 Isaiah 52:7 ➤ Good News! God's going to do it.

 Isaiah 52:12, 14-15 ➤ He will do it all! You will be astonished!

 Isaiah 52:13 ➤ Note carefully three words

 Isaiah 53:1 ➤ Totally unexpected!

Does the Bible specifically say Isaiah 53 is about Jesus?

- O Memorize Isaiah 53:6.
- O Ask God for opportunities to tell about Jesus.

## NOTES FOR FAMILY OR GROUP STUDY

- 1. What are you thankful for? What challenge or stress are you facing? (Consider praying about these together.)
- 2. Read Matthew 8:14-20 together (at least twice), and take turns retelling it in your own words as if sharing with a friend who isn't here.
- 3. What stands out to you and why? What do these verses tell us about God? What do these verses tell us about humanity/about us?
- 4. If this is God speaking, how will you apply it to your life? (*Aim for a specific: "I will..."* step of obedience.)
- 5. Who will you share with before we meet again? (Name a specific person you want to **share with**.)
