

## "How does the Gospel end?"

- 1. The Gospel ends by *clarifying* the grace & mercy of God (Isaiah 65:1-7).
- 2. The Gospel ends with a *clear distinction* being made between those who belong to Jesus and those who do not (Isaiah 65:11-14).
- 3. The Gospel ends with the creation of new heavens and a new earth (Isaiah 65:17-25).
- 4. The Gospel ends by clarifying that everyone has an <u>eternal choice</u> to make (Isaiah 66:1-2).

## **NEXTSTEPS**

- O Memorize Isaiah 66:1-2.
- O What is making you tremble today?
- O Which path are you on?
- O Cheer God on like Isaiah!

## **DISCOVERY QUESTIONS** FOR FAMILY OR GROUP STUDY

- 1. What are you thankful for? What challenge or stress are you facing? *(Consider praying about these together.)*
- 2. Read Revelation 21:1-8 and 22-27 together (at least twice), and take turns retelling it in your own words as if sharing with a friend who isn't here.
- 3. What stands out to you and why? What do these verses tell us about God? What do these verses tell us about humanity/about us?
- 4. If this is God speaking, how will you apply it to your life? (*Aim for a specific: "I will..."* step of obedience.)
- 5. Who will you share with before we meet again? (Name a specific person you want to **share with**.)
