Genesis 1

What does it mean to be created in the image of God? We are:

The greatest confirmation that we are created in the image of God is found in Jesus Christ.

- 1. Jesus came to earth and *took on flesh* (Philippians 2:7).
- 2. Jesus placed the *highest value* upon individuals.

3. Jesus opposed those who took advantage of others (Matthew 23).

- 4. Jesus gave us His Word and sent us His Holy Spirit.
- 5. Jesus is *conforming us* into His image (Colossians 1:15 & Romans 8:29).

## **DISCOVERY QUESTIONS** FOR FAMILY OR GROUP STUDY

- 1. What are you thankful for? What challenge or stress are you facing? *(Consider praying about these together.)*
- 2. Read Genesis 2:1-10 together (at least twice), and take turns retelling it in your own words as if sharing with a friend who isn't here.
- 3. What stands out to you and why? What do these verses tell us about God? What do these verses tell us about humanity/about us?
- 4. If this is God speaking, how will you apply it to your life? (Aim for a specific: **"I will..."** step of obedience.)
- 5. Who will you share with before we meet again? (Name a specific person you want to **share with**.)
