## How do you deal with disappointment in a way that will cause you to both thrive and honor God?

- 1. Don't be surprised or sidetracked by **disappointment**. (John 16:33)
- 2. Refuse to *compare yourself* to others. (John 21:22)
- Understand that God will <u>not explain everything</u> to you.
  Corinthians 12:9-10)
- 4. Only God will **not disappoint** you. (1 Peter 2:6)

#### THE **ONE THING**:

Cling to the big picture: **Jesus will not disappoint you.** 

#### **NEXTSTEPS**

- O Memorize 1 Peter 2:6 (NLT).
- O Celebrate your accomplishments!
- Thank those who have walked alongside you.
- O Refuse to give up.
