KEEPING IT REAL

1 Describe a time in which the Lord met your need in a completely different manner than you expected. How did you feel going through the experience prior to the need being met?

LOOK AT THE BOOK

2 The king of Aram sent Naaman to Jehoram (king of Israel) with about \$450,000 (in today's dollars) of gold and silver. What do you think was their expectation in terms of how the prophet of God (Elisha) might heal Naaman?

3 Elisha required that Naaman do something – in this case, wash in the Jordan River – to receive his healing. Jesus also sometimes required people to do something to receive their answer to prayer. (See Matthew 17:24-27, Mark 3:1-5, and John 9:1-7, for example.) Compare these requirements with the Arameans' expectations.

4 Are there any situations in which the Lord wants you to respond to Him in faith before receiving your answer to prayer? If so, take the step of faith He is requesting.
