The Bible is notorious for pointing out our sins. [Genesis 6:5, 11-12; Exodus 20:13-17; Romans 3:10-12, 23; Galatians 5:19-21; Ephesians 2:1-3]

The Bible is notorious for boldly proclaiming judgment for our sin. [Genesis 6:6-7; Romans 6:23; Ephesians 2:3; Galatians 3:10]

The Bible celebrates what God wants to do for us.

- God wants to provide us with a way of escape, rescue, salvation. 1. (Genesis 6-8)
- God wants to demonstrate His love for us by doing for us what no one 2. else would or could do. (Romans 5:6-8)
- God wants to remove our **condemnation**. (Romans 8:1) 3.
- God wants to pay the *penalty* for our sin. (Romans 6:23) 4.
- God wants to place OUT CUTSE upon His Son. (Galatians 3:13) 5
- God wants to pour out His wrath for our sins upon His Son. 6. (Romans 3:23-26)
- God wants to have compassion upon us. (Psalm 103:13) 7.
- God wants to *remove our sins* from us. (Psalm 103:12) 8.
- God wants to show *how great His love* is for us. (Psalm 103:11) 9.
