



#### Starting Over Roger Ellis, Lead Pastor CBE: p. 463 | NIV: p. 325

So how do you start over after months and years of exile...of blatant disobedience...of disappointment? Is it even possible to go back?

- 1. Make the decision to *return* to God and *act* upon it.
- 2. Pursue the **genuine worship** of God.
- 3. Rest upon the *authority* of the Word of God.
- 4. Recognize the ongoing *presence of God* in your life.
- 5. Refuse to neglect **<u>YOUR CONNECTION</u>** with the people of God.
- 6. Remember your need for **<u>ongoing repentance</u>** before God.
