Telling Jesus NoRoger Ellis, Lead Pastor
Matthew 16:13-24

Today we come to the high point and perhaps the low point in the life of Peter, the one called Rock. Here, Peter boldly declares who Jesus is...yet a few moments later he is totally off base regarding what Jesus had come to do! And it is here that Jesus clarifies His person, His mission & His message:

"My Church is built upon <u>a confession</u>" (16:13-17).

2. "My Church is more powerful **than culture**" (16:18-20).

3. "My Church has one primary message" (16:21-24).

THEONE THING: Never forget who owns the Church.

- O Is your confession a statement or an act of surrender?
- O Connect the rock theme with Matthew 7:24-27.
- Pray Colossians 4:2-6 and look for open doors.
