## LOOK AT THE BOOK

- What does Paul mean by saying that our citizenship is in heaven? How does this compare to Hebrews 12:22-24? Read 2 Peter 1:13-15 and 2 Corinthians 5:4-9. What does it mean we are living in tents by comparison? How does the fact that our citizenship is not here but in heaven motivate you?

## TAKING IT FURTHER

Christ, by His resurrection power, will literally (Philippians 3:21) transform our bodies to be like His glorious resurrection body. How will you cooperate with the Holy Spirit in this process until the day this transformation becomes reality (Romans 12:1-2)?
